SUBJECT: Accident Reporting

1. Reference:

a. AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program (RAR 003, 06/14/2010), 23 August 2007.

b. DA Pam 385-40, Army Accident Investigations and Reporting (RAR 001, 02/01/2010), 6 March 2010.

2. The beforementioned regulations require all Army accidents to be investigated and reported through the chain of command; for tenant units this does not include the US Army Garrison where they are stationed. For me as the Garrison Commander, however, it is essential to have overall information about both, on and off post accidents, including tenant units and not only Garrison employees. in order to provide a safe working and living environment for all soldiers, civilian employees and family members living and working in Bamberg.

3. In the Tenant Unit Commanders Conference on 11 August 2010, all commanders agreed to provide copies of accident reports (DA Form 285,) to the Installation Safety Office (ISO) for information and analysis. The ISO staff will use the accident reports to identify unsafe locations, determine trends and causes, and to develop lessons learned and countermeasures.

4. Safety is every one's responsibility; support from tenant unit safety officers and safety non-commissioned officers is needed to provide a safe working and living environment for soldiers, civilina employees and family members working and living in Bamberg.
