MEMORANDUM FOR USAG Bamberg Soldiers, Civilians and Employees

SUBJECT: Commander's Policy on Curfew Hours

1. Curfew for ages 16 to 17 is from 2400 to 0500 daily. For ages 15 and below, curfew is from 2200 to 0500 Sunday through Thursday and from 2400 to 0500 Friday and Saturday. During the summer when school is not in session, curfew is from 2400 to 0500 for all age groups.
2. Juveniles returning from community or school sponsored athletic contests and social events during curfew hours will have a reasonable amount of time to be in their quarters after arrival in Bamberg, normally not exceeding 30 minutes. The Military police Desk Sergeant (DSN 469-8700/7770) will be notified upon arrival to preclude inadvertent or unintended violations.
3. The High School Principal, the Director of Child and Youth Services, the Community Chaplain or other responsible officials may request an extension of the curfew hours to enable juveniles to participate in activities such as school proms, sunrise services or similar activities. Requests normally should be made in writing to the Garrison Commander not later than three days before the event.
4. The curfew may be broken if an emergency situation exists.
5. Military Police will enforce the curfew. Juveniles picked up by the Military Police will be processed through normal procedures. Sponsors will be required to pick up their children at the MP Station. Sponsors of family members who are repeat offenders may be subject to adverse administrative action to include termination of government quarters and early return of family members to CONUS.
