MEMORANDUM FOR Soldiers, Employees and Family Members of the US Army Garrison, Bamberg

SUBJECT: Traffic Enforcement

1. PURPOSE: To establish additional non-administrative action for violators of traffic regulations and or policies within the USAG Bamberg area of responsibility.
2. SCOPE: This policy applies to all personnel assigned, residing, visiting, and/or under operational control of the USAG Bamberg.
3. REFERENCE:
  - a. AE Reg 190-1, Driver and Vehicle Requirements and Installation Traffic Code for the U.S. Forces in Germany, 13 Aug 10
  - b. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, 22 May 2006
4. POLICY:
  - a. IAW AE Reg 190-1, unless otherwise determined by the USAG Bamberg Commander, the maximum speed limit for vehicles in U.S.-controlled areas is 30 kph. Changes to the 30-kph limit will be posted in all areas affected by the change. The maximum speed for passing marching troops (including physical-training formations) is 15 kph.
  - b. The point system applies to all operators of motor vehicles, on or off the installation. The system also applies to violators reported to installation officials in accordance with AR 190-5, paragraph 4-9 and AE Reg 190-1, table 2-1. Points will be assessed when the person is found to have committed a violation. Adverse action is taken by the unit commander, civilian supervisor or by the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority. Discretionary suspensions may be assessed for periods not to exceed one year. The USAG Bamberg Commander has directed that the suspending authority will suspend a licensee's on post driving privileges for the following offenses which occur within housing/school zones within a 12 month period:

SUBJECT: Traffic Enforcement

(1) For violations for speed exceeding the posted speed limit by 1 kph or more, the following discretionary suspensions in addition to the issuance of a DD Form 1408 (Armed Forces Traffic Citation) with points assessed will be issued:

(a) Second Offense – Suspend on-post driving privileges for 7 calendar days

(b) Third Offense – Suspend on-post driving privileges for 30 calendar days.  
This also requires a counseling letter.

(c) Fourth Offense – Suspend on-post driving privileges for 180 calendar days.

(d) Fifth and Subsequent Offenses – Suspend on-post driving privileges for 365 calendar days.

(2) One Time Warning – first time violators caught speeding from 1-10 kph over the posted speed limit will be given a one-time written warning with no suspension. Any subsequent violations of speeding will be treated IAW paragraph 4.b (1). There is no one-time warning for violators who are caught speeding 11 kph or more.
