SUBJECT: USAG Bamberg's Environmental Management System (EMS) Policy

1. References:

a. Executive Order 13423, 24 Jan 07, subject: Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management.

b. Executive Order 13514, 8 Oct 09, subject: Federal Leadership in Environmental, Energy, and Economic Performance.

2. Purpose. Enhance mission readiness by implementing a mission-focused, International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 14001-conformant EMS.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to all civilian and military personnel, all residents, appropriate contractor, and all host and tenant organizations assigned to the Bamberg Military Community.

4. Policy. The USAG Bamberg provides management of Army installations operations that support readiness and mission execution. Bamberg provides equitable services and facilities, optimizes resources, sustains the environment and enhances "Leading Change for Installation Excellence". At USAG Bamberg we will perform this mission in concert with our stewardship responsibility to protect and conserve the environment. To accomplish this mission we commit to:

a. Compliance with all applicable environmental policies, laws, regulations, and other requirements.

b. Continuous improvement of our environmental performance, minimize the use of resources and prevent pollution to the maximum extent practicable through effective management and planning.

SUBJECT: Continuing USAG Bamberg's Environmental Management System (EMS) Policy

c. Continual assessment of activities and services to determine their effect on the environment. We will identify significant environmental aspects, set and review environmental objectives and targets, and establish performance measures to assess our Management System's effectiveness. Our objectives are:

- (1) Reduce total energy consumption by 30% by FY15 installation-wide (baseline FY03)
- (2) Achieve a minimum recycling rate of 50% by end of FY15
- (3) Reduce installation's drinking water consumption by 26% by end of FY20 (baseline FY07)

d. Increasing environmental awareness throughout the Garrison.

e. Documentation, implementation and maintenance of an efficient and effective EMS that is communicated to everyone working for or on behalf of the organization.
