



Is a *workforce-preparation and apprenticeship enterprise* designed to meet the career – exploration needs of Army Youth.

Youth are placed in paid positions within USAG Bamberg Family and MWR operations.

Career fields may include Marketing & Graphic Design, Sports Management, Education, Food Service, Outdoor Recreation and more.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Be 15-18 years of age (14 year olds may participate in HIRED! training)
- Provide proof of U.S. Citizenship or Nationality
- Register with Child, Youth & School Services (CYSS)
- Maintain 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) or higher
- Complete 6 prerequisite workforce preparation trainings
- Complete 6 ongoing trainings (i.e. resume writing, budgeting, etc.)
- Agree to work 15 hours per week for 12 weeks (180 hours) per apprenticeship term
- Arrange own transportation to and from work site
- Apply and interview for apprenticeship placement

USAG Bamberg - Teen Apprenticeships

Bamberg Child, Youth & School (CYS) Services offers teens of active duty military and DOD employees the opportunity to work a twelve week apprenticeship position through the HIRED! Apprenticeship Program. The program provides a real-world workforce experience while teens build resumes for future careers, experience for college applications and scholarships, and earn a stipend for the term.

Program Benefits

- ✓ Explore personal interests and various career fields
- ✓ Develop employability and life skills
- ✓ Receive job training from an experienced mentor
- ✓ Build resume for future jobs and/or college applications
- ✓ Earn "Cash Award" and certificate through Kansas State University upon completion

The HIRED! Apprentice Will . . .

- Meet all prerequisites as identified on the HIRED! Apprentice Position Description
- Commit to participating for fifteen (15) hours within a seven-day period for twelve (12) consecutive weeks (one HIRED! term lasts twelve [12] weeks)
- Conform to all guidelines, regulations and policies that apply to employees in the organization
- Dress appropriately for the placement site and adhere to dress code requirements
- Conduct oneself respectfully and ethically at the placement site
- Set goals for learning and potential career development
- Maintain employer confidentiality
- Accept feedback and suggestions for improvement in a positive manner
- Achieve a satisfactory evaluation from both the MWR Employer and HIRED! Program Coordinator
- Attend workforce-preparation or secondary education classes (minimum of two [2] per month) as required by the HIRED! Apprenticeship Program
- Participate in training offered by HIRED! Placement Site relevant to position
- Meet with the HIRED! Program Coordinator on a regular basis
- Report to the MWR SM (Site Mentor) if expected to arrive late

- Inform MWR SM when unable to report to placement site due to illness or emergency
- Submit all forms in a timely manner
