SUBJECT: Government Funding for Local Moves

2. This information is intended to clarify the rules for government funded moves versus other non-PCS related moves.

a. The initial move upon arrival into either Government-controlled quarters or private rental housing is at government expense IAW individual assignment orders. **Subsequent moves are paid for only if the Garrison Commander directs the move or the move is for the convenience of the Government.**

b. **Moves for personal convenience or other reasons must be personally funded.** The following list does not cover all situations that may arise; however, it gives a general idea of **moves that are not at government expense.** It includes moves due to

(1) changes in bedroom requirement and rank.

(2) family decision to move from government controlled quarters to private rental.

(3) family requesting to move from private rental to government controlled quarters for personal convenience.

(4) pregnant soldier elects to move from barracks to private rental.

(5) single Soldier marries and elects to move to private rental when government controlled quarters are available.

3. Documents provided by housing for transportation movement of Household Goods (HHGs) will specify whether the move is at government expense or at the Soldier's expense (personal convenience).
