

Armed Forces Network (AFN) Television Services

On-Post Family Housing & Single Soldier Quarters

AFN television services offer 10 Video channels and 8 Audio channels FREE to family housing residents living on-post and to single soldiers living in Soldiers Quarters/barracks. As a provision in the TKS Discreet Bandwidth contract, AFN programming must be provided to family housing or to single Soldier quarters cable outlets without the purchase of additional TKS packages.

You do not need a multi-channel TV system to get AFN. All you have to do is plug in your American TV and connect it to the cable outlet in the wall. If the outlet is PAL, you still do not need a multi-system TV, you will need an adapter for your TV that can be purchased at the Power Zone. If you cannot get AFN programming when you connect and turn-on your American system TV, call the AFN trouble desk at DSN 389-4444; or Commercial - O621-4608-5444.

AFN carries popular stateside TV shows, movies, and both college and pro sports programs. AFN Channels and Programs broadcast schedules are published daily in the Stars and Stripes Newspaper and on the web at www.afneurope.net.
