### Weekly Reminders

#### **The APO is NOT for your business use**

Military Police Customs Investigators recently uncovered several German tax violations in which mail-order items were imported through the Army Post Office for use in someone's part-time business. German tax authorities will want the tax and duty fees due on those goods because they were intended for commercial use or resale. Items sent through the APO are exempt from these levies because they are for your personal use only. You may use the APO to order things for yourself or your immediate family from

companies located outside Germany. If you want to import things for resale, commercial business or to give to someone not authorized customs privileges, you have to use the regular civilian mail or a parcel service, and pay any import duties and taxes. If you don't, you are breaching customs and tax laws by evading those taxes. This rule even applies if you want to buy articles for volunteer organizations you support. 
### Manage Your Holiday Spending

There are only 10 shopping days left 'til Christmas... do you have your holiday shopping done yet? First things first, don't panic! Ideally you've planned and budgeted for the holidays all year long so you're ready to head to PX today, right? If not, avoid the stress, strain and overspending by following these tips for last minute holiday shopping.



When time runs short holiday shoppers have the tendency to over spend due to lack of planning. For whatever reason you put off your holiday shopping, (too busy, no money, limited gift ideas...) don't blow the budget just because you're short on time.

### Last Minute Holiday Spending Tips



#### #1 — Make a List

This is a must before you head to the store or go online - It takes a few minutes and keeps you focused.

#### Your list should include:

- Gift recipients and a budgeted amount per person.
- Gift ideas for each recipient and approximate cost.
- Your budgeted amount should include shipping fees if necessary. The suggested mail date for USPS Priority packages from Europe to CONUS has passed. It now may be fairly expensive to get that cuckoo clock under Grandma's tree by Dec 25th. (*Maybe consider a different gift?*)
- If you are shopping on the economy don't forget the Dollar to Euro conversion rate. The average cost lately has been around \$1.27 for 1 Euro.

#### #2 — Shop around (Yes guys, that means you too.)

#### #3 — Don't try to get it done all in one day



Set aside at least two days. Start with the easiest gifts on your list and get that done first. Keep your budget in mind as you shop for recipients who are hard to buy for. Save your receipts in case you change your mind. Most shops on the economy close by 7 p.m. on Saturdays and are not open on Sundays. Your best bet is to head out on Thursdays when shops are open later than normal hours.

#### #4 — Give a Gift Card

Gift certificates and gift cards make great gifts and are a great way to control spending.

#### #5 — Borrow Wisely

Shopping online makes it almost impossible to pay cash for your purchases. When you use a credit card, plan to repay the owed amount immediately to avoid finance charges.

#### #6 — Draw names

If your list of family and friends is long consider drawing names to reduce the amount of gifts you give this season.



**Candle with Care this Holiday Season**

- Keep candles away from combustible materials, such as decorations, paper, wreaths and boughs.
- Place candles away from places that could be knocked over by a person or pet.
- Use sturdy, non-combustible candleholders that can collect dripping wax and won't tip over.
- Extinguish a candle when 2 inches of wax remains or a half-inch if the candle is in a container. This prevents heat damage to the surface and stops glass containers from breaking.
- Always keep candles, as well as matches and lighters, out of the reach of children, and don't leave children unattended in a room with lit candles.
- Never use lit candles to decorate Christmas trees.
- Always extinguish candles when leaving the room or going to sleep.
- Remember that a candle is an open flame. It can easily ignite any combustible nearby.
